







## 7 Key Insights


- The combined top 13 African titles on this list cumulated to 126M views
- 3 hit titles are adapted from Netflix foreign hit shows
- 7 of the top 13 titles are Movies, whilst 5 of 6 series are South African
- South Africa to Nigeria's hit ratio is 8:5. SA has a higher percentage of hits due to the number of quality series productions
- Kings of Joburg gets a double appearance on the hit charts
- Fatal Seduction series is the only African title to hit triple-digit watched hours. This is driven by its sex appeal scenes and suspense storyline
- Shanty Town greenlit for second season, Jagun Jagun sequel in the works
